Slot Limit for KBR

This year, going against our solid catch and release policy, KBR has decided to allow fish between ½ lb and 1.5 lbs. to be removed from the lake.

These fish may be eaten (don't clean 'em at the park), taken away, or if you like, transplanted to other ponds on the Ranch (which means they will have to be moved to the ponds immediately after catching).

The spillway pond is close to the launch ramp, so this is an ideal place to move fish to. Once this pond is populated, it will be a great place for some fun bank-fishing for everyone - kids too!
