Bass Ranch owner, Jon Kelsey makes this report: 01/01/02 The normally quiet winter fishing month of December has not turned out to be so dormant. With the heavy rain of last week the fish have turned on. The lake is almost full, rising 3 feet in the last four days. It is expected to fill by Thursday with the next storm tomorrow. Fish are being caught by the dam and at the winter time inlet to the lake, where the creek enters the lake. Jigs seem to be hot right now.

01/04/02 Don Payne fished the lake this afternoon. He caught 15 fish using black and red flake brush hogs with a glass and brass weight set up to make some noise to draw attention. Fishing was hot at the confluence of the fresh water coming in and lake water in the creek channel. The lake is two inches from being full.

01/21/02 Scott George reports: Got to the lake around 1pm on Sunday-sun was out and almost no wind. Basically fished the perimeter of the lake throwing crankbaits and spinnerbaits up in the shallow water. Caught 6 fish in 4 hours but all were thick, fat, beautiful and well - typical Kelsey bass - 2 went 4lbs. or better.
