Friday, June 8th, 2001...

From Chowchilla, Scott George tells us...Got to the lake around 4:30pm.....WINDY,WINDY,WINDY! I didn't think it was gonna be great with all the wind, but I was soon corrected! Caught 27 up to 4 lbs. Almost all the fish came off crankbaits in the main body of the lake, one on a worm/darter head off the dam and the rest off a white buzzbait towards dark. Weeds are coming back strong, but that can be a good thing! Tight lines to you!

Tuesday, June 12th, 2001...

From Dave Kochis...Went fishing June 12th. It was very very windy. I was unable to adequately position the boat in order to fish where and how I wanted. Even at that I was able to catch 16 fish. Five on top water, 2 cranking and 9 on the Senko.

Wednesday, June 20th, 2001...

From Ron Lara....Went to the lake on Wed, June 20. Great day, not too much wind but very hot!!! both topwater and grubs, worms did the trick with the largest being a 4.5 pounder. We caught 31 bass for the day. All from 2-4.5 pounds. Lots of laughs and great BBQ. Weeds starting to take over will have to go to topwater weedless soon.
